#### School Hours

Please note that the College is open from 8:00am to 5:00pm on school days.

#### Attendance and Absences

- If students will be absent from school, parents/carers are requested to notify the College in advance, or on the day of the absence, by emailing <a href="mailto:student.services@merici.edu.au">student.services@merici.edu.au</a>.
- If a student is absent, or late to school, and contact from a parent/carer has not been received, the College will send an SMS message to the parent/carer. Parents/carers are asked to respond to the SMS
- acknowledging receipt of the SMS and approving the absence.
- A medical certificate needs to be produced for absences exceeding three consecutive days.
- Applications for approved leave must be made in writing to the Principal, through the Assistant Principal Teaching and Learning prior to the leave being taken.
- Early Departure Parent/Guardian are required to with notice email <u>student.services@merici.act.edu.au</u> advising student name, what time they will be collecting the student and the reason for early departure.
- Students are then required to come to Student Services and wait until their parent arrives to collect them
- Late arrival On arrival to school, students arriving late need to sign into Student Services kiosk.

#### Compass/SEQTA Clarification

Compass is the enrolment and parent portal for the Catholic Education Office and allows **parents only** to manage:

- Fees payments
- Parent relationships
- Contact details such as mobile and change of address
- Excursion permissions
- Medical consent forms

Unlike the primary schools, Merici College and their teachers does not use Compass for day to day class activities and communications with teachers. Those functions are covered by SEQTA.

#### Temporary Arrangements during Building Works

During the renovation of the main entrance and administration office space at Merici College, which is expected to take all of Term 1, some changes are being put in place to accommodate safe movement of people onsite and those visiting.

- The front door to the College has been barricaded off. There is no access through the main entrance.
- The entrance through the Auditorium foyer remains open for now but will be closed later as building works progress.
- The main Reception Office, along with Student Services and Finance Office has been temporarily relocated to the classroom known as C2.
- Access to Reception is via the main carpark on Wise Street, right next door to the Auditorium building.
- Parents can park in the Wise Street carpark when visiting the College and enter using the external stairs that lead through the iron gates to the main quadrangle. You'll see entrance doors to Reception on the left. There is signage to assist.
- DROP OFF of students WILL NOT occur in the usual place in the carpark. Instead, drop off will be on
  Wise Street between the 2 red gates of the main carpark. Please DO NOT enter the Carpark for drop off
  as it will be too congested.
- PICK UP is at the same point on Wise Street i.e, between the 2 red gates, but pick-up will be restricted to between **3:10pm and 3:25pm**. Thereafter buses take over.
- Supervision by staff in hi-viz vests will be provided.
- If you attempt to park on Wise street to wait for your daughter you will be asked to move on, similar to airport pick up and drop off zone. Again, this is to avoid congestion and increased risk of mishap or injury.

These arrangements will be trialled for all of Weeks 1 and 2 and may change if it improves safety. Any change in arrangements will be conveyed to the community.

We thank all parents for your patience during these renovations and welcome any constructive suggestions or feedback which will help us manage safety better during this time.

### **COUNSELLORS CORNER**

Welcome back to all our returning students, and a warm welcome to the newcomers, parents and caregivers! As we head into another school year, transitions are often an uncomfortable yet shared experience, often accompanied by a range of emotions and feelings – such as excitement, and possibly a touch of apprehension.

Whether it is your first day of school or moving to a higher grade, common feelings like anticipation, nervousness, worry, and anxiety may arise. It is important to recognise and normalise these emotions, in order to embrace a smoother transition.

Parents and caregivers can play an important role in supporting their daughters through these transitions through open communication and actively listening to concerns. Additional practical strategies include:

- o Reintroduce Routines: establish consistent bedtime routines for better sleep hygiene.
- o Open Communication: talk openly about your daughter's feelings about returning to school. Is she excited? Nervous? Worried about anything specific? Validate her emotions and offer reassurance.
- Mind the Body: encourage healthy habits like regular exercise, balanced meals, and relaxation techniques to manage stress and promote emotional well-being.

Merici College offers School Counselling during school hours throughout the school year, this service is delivered by qualified mental health professionals with experience working with young people who present with a variety of mental health concerns. It is our role to foster conditions within the school context that maximise educational equity, student wellbeing and learning success for all students.

School Counselling is a short term, goal-focused therapy available to students to reduce the impact that their mental health may be having on their learning and life. It is important to know that School Counselling is not a long-term support service and is therefore not always able to provide the length or depth of support that some students may need to maximise their chance of recovery.


#### **Dance Troupe Performances**
