### 2025 Enrolment Process

Please note that Mrs Masters has commenced enrolment interviews for 2025. If you are interested in submitting an enrolment application, please follow the link <u>https://www.merici.act.edu.au/enrolment</u>. Please ensure that all supporting documentation is uploaded as required. Documentation includes:

- Birth certificate (not commemorative) or passport.
- Certificate of Baptism (if applicable).
- Last report from previous school (This documentation is required for all applications at Merici College.)
- Family Law, Personal Protection Order or Other Relevant Court Orders (if applicable)
- Visa grant notice for permanent and temporary visa-holders (if applicable) for both student and parent(s) / legal guardian(s)
- Any medical reports and/or other assessment reports for students with additional learning needs (if applicable).

If your daughter is currently attending Year 6 at one of our Catholic Education (CE) primary schools, please ensure that the information entered on the College enrolment application is the same as the information you have previously provided when enrolling your daughter at their primary school. (For example, residential address, email, telephone number).

Year 11 and 12 BSSS students will sit their end of Semester 1 Exams on Friday 7 June and between Tuesday 11 June to Friday 14 June in the College Auditorium. Students have been emailed their individual timetables. Students are expected to attend all exams. They are not required to be at school outside of their exams.

No BSSS classes will run during this week. If students are unable to attend exams, medical certificates are required to cover any absences to avoid academic penalties.

The last day for school attendance for Year 11 and 12 BSSS students is Monday 17 June.

### Year 11 2025 Subject Selections due by Friday 28 June

Year 10 students have received an email with their link to their subject selections for Year 11 2025. Students will need to enter their study package (BSSS or IB) as well as their individual subjects. Students are encouraged to speak with their teachers about subjects of interest to them and read through their Senior Subject Handbooks given out in their information pack at the Information Evening.

Students are asked to enter their subject choices by Friday 28 June. Their selections will then be discussed at their individual transitions meetings that are being held until the end of Term 2.

Our names are Holly and Jess, and we are your student ambassadors for the Push Up Challenge in 2024! Registrations are open and we're back again to promote mental health at Merici and have fun while doing it!

We're getting involved in The Push-Up Challenge from 5-28 June 2024 and would love you to join us.

The Challenge is to complete 3,249 push-ups (or 1,625 if you choose the half target) in 24 days to raise awareness and funds for mental health. This represents the 3,249 people who died by suicide in Australia in 2022 (the most recent stats), which is why we want to push for better, and hope you will too.

Sound like too many push-ups? No worries, you can do the half target and substitute push-ups for alternative exercises, like squats and sit-ups.



It's free to take part and there's an app where you get daily targets and mental health facts, track your progress, and can check out our collective stats.

We have created a community, which is a group of Teams all participating in The Push-Up Challenge and pushing together. By joining our community as part of a team which are done by your PC's, we'll be able to track our collective stats, as well as see our own personal leader board for Teams and individuals.
