#### Year 10-12 Exams BSSS

Exams for Years 10-12 will be held on the following dates:

Students have been emailed their individual exam timetable so that they are aware of what exams they have and when they are scheduled. Exams will take place in the Auditorium. Students with special considerations have been emailed about the location of their exams.

Students in Years 11 & 12 are only required to be at school when they have exams. Students should remain at home outside of their exams. Students are not required to wear school uniform for their exams, comfortable clothing is recommended.

#### Year 10-12 Swim Teacher Australia Qualification

Merici College is proud to offer a new opportunity to students who are 16 years and over. Students have the opportunity to gain a qualification as a Swim teacher. The Swim Teacher Australia certificate will be run from Monday 4 December – Wednesday 6 December. Students will then need to complete 20 hours with a swim teacher in order to gain their qualification. These 20 hours can be completed through Aquatots who have locations in Gold Creek, Forde and Googong. Once that has been completed the successful students will gain a certificate of Attainment with the competence and knowledge to teach swimming and water safety to independent learners in groups of varying sizes.

The course will be delivered by Rhiannon Kocmar who was recently named Swim Australia Teacher of the Year 2023. She has also just been appointed as the National Education Officer for Swim Australia.

This entry level course features:

- Best practice blended learning delivery
- Online login enabling some self-paced theory study
- Practical sessions working with an industry provider and a primary school.

Students will complete theory components and CPR on Monday 4 December at Merici College. Tuesday 5 December and Wednesday 6 December will be based at Aquatots Gold Creek.

The cost for this course has been discounted for us and will be \$260.

#### Year 9 Driver Safety Training Program Consent and Payment (27 November – 5 December)

Merici College is proud to offer a new opportunity to Year 9 students which will be run by Ascent Training services. This half day program will include a safety workshop, vehicle demonstration and a supervised drive of a dual-control vehicle on a purpose-built track.

The program will include:

- Road safety workshop involving discussion about sharing the road, passing distances for cyclists, fun
  interactive activities about braking times, the effects of alcohol on driving ability and a road rules quiz
- Vehicle demonstration describing the components of a vehicle, including safety features and general maintenance.
- Supervised drive in a dual-control vehicle in a controlled environment to give the students their first experience of driving a vehicle and what is required to do it safely.

This program will take place at Fairbairn Hill Climb Circuit, Sutton Road, near Queanbeyan.

The course will be run on four occasions:

- 27 November 8:45am-1:00pm
- 28 November 11:00am-3:00pm
- 29 November 8:45am-1:00pm
- 5 December 8:45am-1:00pm

Students will be allocated one day on which they will attend, they will be required to be in PE uniform and bring a packed lunch on their day. Students will be transported by bus to and from the venue. Please note this day is optional and students not attending will continue with their regular classes.

The cost per student will be \$254 and payment is due prior to **Monday 20 November**. Once students have paid, they will be allocated a specific day to attend.

Additional to this course, Year 9 students will also be attending a heavy vehicle demonstration during Period 6 on Tuesday 5 December which will include a presentation and an opportunity to explore some different heavy vehicles.

## Year 9 Road Ready Pre-Learner Licence Training Course

Merici College will be offering the Road Ready Pre-Learner Licence Training Course to eligible students on 1 December and 4 December. There is no cost for this course, and it will be facilitated by the HPE faculty.

Students who are 15 years or older on 4 December this year and live in the ACT are eligible for this. Once completed the Pre-Learner Licence Training Course is **valid for 1 year**.

The ACT Government has developed this Pre-Learner Licence Training Course (PLLC) for people who wish to apply for a learner licence (L-Plates). The Pre- Learner Licence Training Course educates new drivers about safe driving practices and ACT road rules. A person must successfully complete the course to be issued with an ACT learner licence.

Merici College will run this Road Ready Course on **Friday 1 December and Monday 4 December** from **8.45am – 3:00pm.** Students must complete both days and pass the test.
